History

ITU Development Foundation Schools started their educational journey with Private Sedat Üründül Kindergarten in 2000, continue their education activities in Natuk Birkan Primary School (2001), Ekrem Elginkan High School (2005), Beylerbeyi Private Kindergarten and Primary School, which started to serve in 2011 in Istanbul Ayazağa and Beylerbeyi campuses.

ITU GVO, which provides education in four different schools in Istanbul, chose Izmir to continue its education activities outside İstanbul, for this reason they collaborated with NESAN Group of Companies, one of the most distinguished industrial organizations in Izmir.

Since 2014, NESAN Group of Companies has undertaken the representation and investment of ITU GVO in Izmir. Izmir Kindergarten, Primary School, Middle School and High School have been opened as the newest link of ITU Development Foundation Schools (GVO).

ITU GVO Izmir Schools continue their educational activities as a k-12 school by welcoming kindergarten students in the 2014 academic year, elementary and middle school students in 2015 and high school students in the 2016 academic year. The first graduates of ITU Development Foundation Private Izmir Anatolian High School left the school in 2020.

ITU Development Foundation Schools have been structured as five separate schools under the same roof of Cultural Inc. The Education Advisory Board, which consists of faculty members, determines the education policies of schools, directs and supervises their functioning and academic development in accordance with the principles. Our students, who are educated in the buildings

equipped with a contemporary understanding and technology, are supported by the cultural heritage, accumulation and education staff of Istanbul Technical University, offered an opportunity to continue their education in an integrated system.

Student Admission Requirements

Admission to our school is conducted based on MEB High School entrance exam and ITU High School Entrance Exam results

Students who pass the exams successfully are interviewed by the School Counselling Service in order to get to know the students.

Every student welcomed to ITU Development Foundation Izmir High School is enrolled in the Prep Class. The prep class is a one-year education that is predominantly in English. As well as English classes, there are courses from other academic branches. Students who wish to pass the prep class are required to take the Prep Exemption Exam. Students who score above 70 in this exam go directly to the 9th grade. Those who fail the exam study in the Prep Class for one year.

Curriculum

ITU GVO Izmir follows the national high school curriculum determined by the Ministry of National Education. Since our school is in the category of "Anatolian High Schools with Preparatory Class", it focuses on foreign language education. English is the primary foreign language at our school. Students choose a second foreign language, either German or Spanish. Within the scope of English education, terminology of mathematics and science lessons are given in English in the 9th and 10th grades. In the 11th and 12th grades, courses are given in Turkish in order to prepare students for the national

university placement exams. AP Calculus, AB and AP English Language and Composition courses are offered for students who want to take the AP exams. The school has many extracurricular clubs and cultural, artistic and sports activities are held in our school throughout the year.

Grade Point Average (GPA)

Average grade is calculated by using grading table above. Starting from the ninth grade, all successful or unsuccessful courses are included in the calculation. All courses must be completed with a grade above 50 for gradu - ation. Grades are recorded on the transcript and the GPA is calculated in January and June.

Teaching Staff

- •In our Teaching Staff; There are 76 full-time and 6 part-time teachers.
- •The mother tongue of 3 teachers is English.
- •The student teacher ratio is 6 to 1 and a class consists of 16 students on average.

Students

There are 499 students between the ages of 3 and 18 in ITU Development Foundation Izmir Schools, from kindergarten to grade 12 (K-12). 70 Kindergarten, 123 Primary School, 175 Middle School, 131 High School.
